




It offers a diverse range of original and fan art prints, comics, handmade crafts, stickers, buttons, and jewelry. It's the go-to place for unique creations, fostering direct connections between artists and their audience/buyers.

Contact organizers via Instagram

Follow & subscribe to the Convention's Instagram page to get updates about its events and happenings. To contact the organizer or advertising team, send them a DM! (Direct message) inquiring about Artist Alley and how to apply.

This method can be employed for a multitude of purposes.

- When a convention only has social media
- if you can't find the artist alley application on their site
- If Artist Alley is sold out but you'd like to still inquire.
- If the convention has not gotten back to you via website/email.





Community

It Takes a Village!

Have friends that attend conventions? How about gamer friends and cosplayers? Sometimes the connection is there-- all you have to do is ask! At a convention? Perfect time to ask a volunteer for information/ask to talk to one of the planners/managers. Introduce yourself and get their contact info to reach out!

Go for it! Similarly, you can message artists on social media!




Sold Out?

There's still hope!

Utilize the social media system to directly contact organizers and inquire about open slots that may not be publicly known. Connect with them to explore potential opportunities and secure a spot that might not be advertised.

Don't Be Afraid to Be Annoying! It often pays off!





Applications

Elaborate on what you want to discuss.

First Come First Serve

The earlier you submit your application and pay for it, the higher your chances of getting a slot. Once the organizers confirm your application, based on available slots and other applicants, your spot is locked in. These slots fill up quickly.

Juried Application

Involves a convention committee overseeing the selection process. The committee carefully evaluates applications to curate a diverse and high-quality artist alley experience. Artists are chosen based on the event's theme, goals, and the representation they can bring to the space. These applications often require artists to provide more detailed information, such as portfolio samples. The committee reviews and compares submissions before selecting their pool of artists.




Fill out Information

Fill out the application with your information.



Submit requested samples of your work if requested.





What to Submit:


Jurors seek clear and concise examples of your work and products. It's ideal to have a dedicated platform for this purpose. Avoid relying solely on social media, like Instagram, as it may not fully showcase your products, especially if you have various content. Consider using platforms like Etsy, Threadless, Red Bubble, Ko-fi shops, or creating a merchandise page or store on your website. This ensures a focused presentation of your artwork and products to impress the jurors.






No Shop? Website? No Problem

Showcase your art on free portfolio platforms! Take clear product photos, upload them, and name them for the convention's artist alley application (e.g., "AniTomo Artist Alley Application 2023"). Submit the link. You can also create a PDF compilation with clear descriptions and costs. Present your work professionally and comprehensively.





Tabled before?

If you have tabled before, provide photo examples of your previous setups. You can also create a mock-up at home to showcase your products. Note: Some conventions may not accept drawn/digital mock-ups, so check their guidelines. When in doubt, ask for clarification!

Tables & Set Up

The Art of Tabling


4Ft Table


Typically suited for smaller conventions or artists with a limited inventory.



6 Rable

Typically suited for smaller conventions or artists with a limited inventory.





Tables often include 2 chairs, 2 badges, and sometimes tablecloths in the artist alley submission fee. Additional chairs may require extra payment, usually equivalent to a badge or half its price. It's best to discuss these details with the convention organizer.

Read Application Guidelines

While most of this information can be found in the artist alley application, if anything is unclear, don't hesitate to ask! Here are some helpful prompts for your questions:

- What's the policy on extra chairs?
- Are table clothes included?
- Am I allowed Helpers/Volunteers? how many?
- What's the deadline for application deposits if chosen?




Table Strategy



Plan Your Table set up

Dedicate a day/evening to mock up your table setup and capture detailed photos. This way, when you arrive at the event, you'll have a clear plan in mind, preventing lastminute confusion and ensuring a smooth setup process.



Packing

Ideally, a full day before
the convention to pack all
the necessary supplies
and merchandise for the
event. Being wellprepared ensures a
smooth and organized
experience.



Payment Options:

Before the convention, ensure you have your payment methods covered: cash and card are the rule of thumb.


Accept card payments through peer-to-peer contact apps like Venmo, Cash App, or Square for added convenience.



More on Money:

- Ideally, bring \$150 in cash, including a mix of \$5s, \$10s, and \$20s denominations.
- Carry your cash on you at all times I ideally in a fanny pack in our pouch you can stash by you.
- Carry a card reader for digital transactions.
 Sign up for the Square app to get a free card reader, allowing you to accept payments conveniently and securely.
